

Annual Spanish courses **Oct 2022-May 2023 A1/A2/B1/B2**

What is the course like? The course will be in the “Remote” modality. The classes will be live via videoconference. We will work on grammar, vocabulary and Spanish culture through oral and written skills.

When are the classes? From October 17, 2022, to May 31, 2023.
Schedules available:

- Monday to Friday from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. (Choose 2 days a week)
- Monday to Friday from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Choose 2 days a week)

What are the groups like? Mín. 5, máx. 12 students

Who are the teachers? Highly qualified native or bilingual teachers.

How much does it cost?

- €155 per month for external students (material not included in the price)
- €130 per month for current students, AESIC students and former students of ESIC Idiomas (Material not included in the price)

*At the beginning of the course, **1.5 monthly payments must be made**, corresponding to the current month (half month) plus the month of May.*

Do I need to take a level test? It will be necessary to take a written level test through our web page <https://www.esic.edu/idiomas> and, if necessary, an oral test by appointment
