Terms and Conditions of the Award

Objective

The aim of this award is to recognize the excellence of the **Final Degree Projects in Entrepreneurship**. It also seeks to promote and support business ideas in our university community, and at the same time, boost entrepreneurial spirit and innovation.

Recipients, Requirements and Awards:

1. Recipients:

Students: Students who are studying at ESIC in any campus and have presented their TFG in the academic year in question.

2.- Requirements

Students who have presented their Final Degree Project within the academic year in question and have obtained from the tribunal a grade equal to or greater than 8 points.



3.- Awards

The following prizes shall be awarded:

In first place:

- **1.000 euros.**
- **Expert advice** for the implementation of their project by the ESIC Entrepreneurs Area of corresponding campus.
- **Publication of the TFG** prior approval of ESIC Editorial.
- **Gift package by sponsors.**

In second and third place:

- **Expert advice for the implementation of their project by the ESIC Entrepreneurs Area of corresponding campus.**
- **Gift package by sponsors.**

All finalists will receive an Accredited Diploma for their participation.

Tutorial Award (Teaching and research staff): The tutor of the winning TFG group will receive:

An Accredited Diploma.

Award Phases

Phase One: Students must carry out and defend their TFG in Entrepreneurship before the academic tribunal.

Phase Two: The Management of the TFG together with the Academic Department of Business Management and ESIC Entrepreneurs will select the finalists from among all the projects that have obtained a grade above eight and have been recommended by the presidents of the TFG Tribunals.



Phase Three: The finalists will present their TFG to a tribunal that will assess the technical quality of the work in accordance with the evaluation criteria established in the Selection process terms and conditions. At the end of the presentation of the projects, the tribunal will deliberate and announce the finalists.

The following evaluation criteria shall be used for the selection of the finalists:

- Opportunity and value contribution of the initiative
- Technical, commercial, economic and financial feasibility.
- Innovation degree and responsible impact.
- Coherence in the presentation.

Academic Committee (Tribunal)

The tribunal will consist of business and teaching professionals chosen by the Academic Department of Business Management, the Entrepreneurship Area of the PDU and the Management of TFG.
